2006 Charles Smith Wines "Royal City" Syrah

Stoneridge Vineyard - Columbia Valley \$105

2005 Charles Smith Wines "Heart" Syrah - Royal Slope Columbia Valley \$100

These are stunning syrahs that must be tasted to be believed.

2007 K Syrah "Clifton" – Wahluke Slope \$37.95

Sun-drenched ripe boysenberry, black pepper, fennel and mouth coating finish.

2007 K Syrah "Northridge" – Wahluke Slope \$37.95

Extremely concentrated, intense color. Notes of huckleberry, cedar, cigar and kirsch. Exuberant ripe fruit with grippy backbone and spice and a seamless finish.

2007 K "El Jefe" En Chamberlin Vineyard – Walla Walla Valley \$67.95

(75% Tempranillo, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon) Barcelona, Madrid, Valencia one sip of this meaty, earthy, gamey Tempranillo will take you there. Why buy a ticket to Spain when you can drink El Jefe. It's the boss.

2007 K "Roma" En Chamberlin Vineyard – Walla Walla Valley \$67.95

(62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 38% Syrah) Rich and focused, this wine delivers super complex flavors and long smooth texture. Black currants, pipe tobacco, cool stone, more than ample flavor. Named for my mother Roma.

2007 K Syrah "Milbrandt" – Wahluke Slope \$27.95

As the day is long...a never ending finish of spices, fresh tobacco, cured meats, and stone. So smooth, so fine.

2007 K “The Deal” Sundance Vineyard – Wahluke Slope **\$37.95**

(100% Syrah) Balanced with berry fruit, game and gravel; a tremendous wine at any price.

2007 K “The Creator” – Walla Walla Valley **SOLD OUT**

(60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 40% Syrah) Pencil lead, spice, pipe tobacco with a core of currant and figs.

2006 K “The Creator” – Walla Walla Valley **\$100**

Pencil lead, spice, pipe tobacco. Rich and pleasurable. Complex as hell. With a pure soul. Whether you’re going to Heaven or Hell, The Creator cannot be missed! (365 cases)

2003 K “Guido” – Walla Walla Valley **\$55.95**

(80% Sangiovese, 20% Syrah) Bellissimo! Rose petals, cherry blossoms...black cherries, cedar, leather, crème caramel with a hint of anise. It’s like an Italian feast.

2006 Charles Smith Wines “Chateau Smith” Cabernet Sauvignon **\$21.95**

Not Bordeaux. Pure Washington! Cedar, No2 pencil, tobacco leaf. There is a ribbon of red currant running through the core of the beautiful and complex Cabernet Sauvignon. VIVE LE CHATEAU SMITH!

2006 K “The Boy” – Walla Walla Valley **\$45**

(94% Grenache, 6% Syrah)
Each year the Grenache gets deeper & deeper. You smell the earth, the rocks, the sunshine and the wind. This is a vineyard in the bottle.

2006 K Syrah “Pheasant” – Wahluke Slope **\$39.95**

A first time caller, this deep-earth, gamy Syrah also shows beautiful finesse and is beautiful to drink. (191 cases)
